LIBRARY TIP

There is no 'one-stop shop' when it comes to finding journal articles online. An article may be available in Westlaw, in Lexis Library, in another database or directly from the publisher website. Do not rely on just Westlaw or Lexis Library because they do not have it all!

Try the Library's collections of print & e-resources. It is a search engine which searches multiple databases, including Westlaw and Lexis Library saving you time and searching resources you may considered. not have Access DISCOVER from the University of Liverpool home at page https://www.liverpool.ac.uk/library/ or click the **DISCOVER** icon above.

Just paste the title of the article into the search box and click the **Search** button:



If **DISCOVER** finds your article, you'll see it in the results list:



Sometimes you may see an article listed more than once; this just means that it is available in more than one place.

Click on one of the green

Get Full Text buttons and follow a link to the full-text.
