A LAW TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS LAW (SECOND REVISION)

ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

This Law may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Law, 1985.

Amendment of s. 41 of the principal Law.

Section 41 of the Customs Law(Second Revision) (hereinafter called the "principal Law") is amended by the deletion of subsection

Amendment of 1st Schedule to the principal Law.

3. (1) The First Schedule to the principal Law is amended in Chapter IX thereof by the addition, immediately following item 9.04, of the following new item -

> "9.05 Purified, desalinated and natural waters other than aerated waters

"10.02

Cigarettes

\$10.00 per 1000".

FREE".

Amendment of 2nd Schedule to the principal Law.

- 4. The Second Schedule to the principal Law is amended by the deletion of item 30 thereof and the substitution therefor of the following item
 - "30 Yachts, boats and such other craft whose length exceeds twenty-five feet measured from the clipper board to the stern end of the transom, and who arrived in the Islands under their own power."

Amendment of 3r Schedule to the principal Law. 5. The Third Schedule to the principal Law is amended by the deletion of items 3 and 8 thereof and the substitution therefor of the following items -

"3	Goods in packages – for each 100 lbs. or part thereof	Per Package	0.50
8	Unpackaged goods - for each 100 lbs or part thereof	Weight	0.50".
