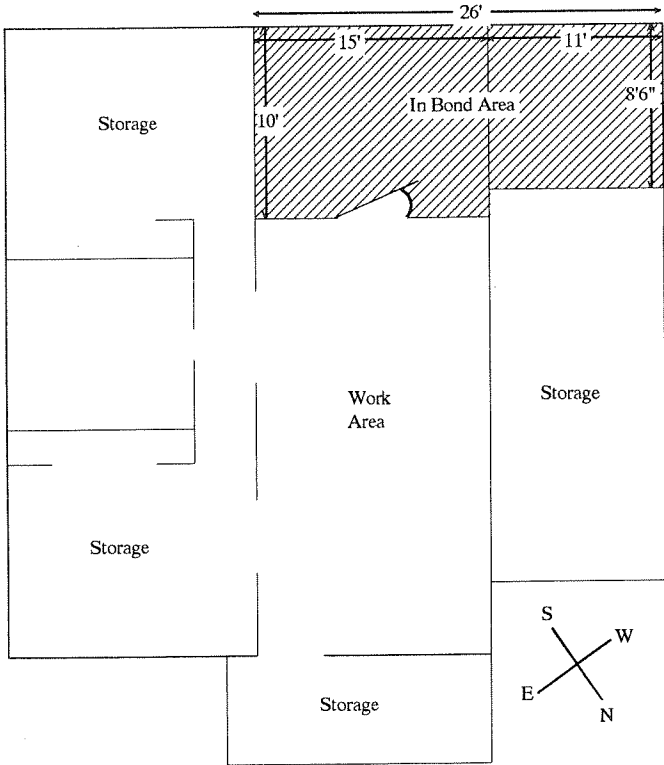
In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 73(c) of the Customs Law (Second Revision) the following Regulations are hereby made -

| Citation. | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Prescribed Warehouse) Regulations 1990. |
| Prescription of Ware-house. | 2. Subject to the conditions set out in the Second Schedule, the premises described in the First Schedule are hereby prescribed to be a warehouse within the meaning of that term as defined in section 2 of the Law, and for the purposes thereof. |
| Warehouse Keeper. | 3. The person named in the Third Schedule is authorised to be the keeper of the warehouse prescribed in regulation 2. |
| Revocation of Customs (prescribed Warehouse) Regs. 1989. | 4. The Customs (Prescribed Warehouse) Regulations 1989, made on the 19th day of December 1989 and published in Supplement No.1 to Gazette No.1 dated 2nd January 1990, are hereby revoked. |

FIRST SCHEDULE

That portion of the Terminal Building located at the Owen Roberts Airport consisting of two connecting areas measuring respectively fifteen feet long by ten feet wide and eleven feet long by eight feet six inches wide having an overall length of twenty-six feet being part of Block No.20C Parcel 25 and being of the shape and dimensions as appear on the Plan thereof annexed hereto and hatched thereon.
