# THE CUSTOMS LAW, 1990

## THE CUSTOMS (GRAND CAYMAN BOTTLERS & BLENDERS) **REGULATIONS 1994**

The Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 73 of the Customs Law, 1990, makes the following regulations —

1. These regulations may be cited as the Customs (Grand Cayman Bottlers & Blenders) Regulations 1994.

## Prescribed warehouse


Subject to compliance with the conditions specified in Schedule 2, the premises described in Schedule 1 are a bonded warehouse.

3. The person named in Schedule 3 is nominated to be a warehouse keeper of the warehouse referred to in regulation 2.

#### Schedule 1

### Description of bonded warehouse

That portion of the building shaded in the floor-plan shown below, being a part of Registration Section George Town East Block 20E Parcel 32.



#### Schedule 2

No goods other than those of Grand Cayman Bottlers and Blenders Limited, or any of its wholly owned subsidiaries, or their respective customers, shall be stored in the bonded warehouse.
