THE CUSTOMS (GRAND CAYMAN BOTTLERS & BLENDERS) REGULATIONS 1994

The Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 73 of the Customs Law, 1990, makes the following regulations –

Title

1. These regulations may be cited as the Customs (Grand Cayman Bottlers & Blenders) Regulations 1994.

Prescribed warehouse

2. Subject to compliance with the conditions specified in Schedule 2, the premises described in Schedule 1 are a bonded warehouse.

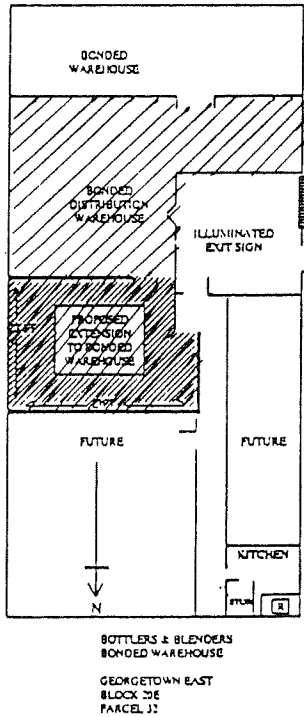
Warehousekeeper

3. The person named in Schedule 3 is nominated to be a warehouse keeper of the warehouse referred to in regulation 2.

Schedule 1

Description of bonded warehouse

That portion of the building shaded in the floor-plan shown below, being a part of Registration Section George Town East Block 20E Parcel 32.



Schedule 2

No goods other than those of Grand Cayman Bottlers and Blenders Limited, or any of its wholly owned subsidiaries, or their respective customers, shall be stored in the bonded warehouse.

Schedule 3

Warehouse Keeper

The warehouse keeper is Dana Caswell.
