Amendment of section 13(2) of the Principal

- 4. Section 13(2) of the principal Law is amended by substituting the following for paragraph (g)
  - "(g) (i) water produced on private residential property for domestic use thereon:
    - (ii) water supplied by the management of condominiums, apartment complexes, multi-family dwellings, hotels, or any other commercial enterprise, for use on their premises by residents therein, provided that the water so supplied is obtained from a concessionaire;".

Saving.

5. Nothing in Section 13(2)(g) of the principal Law shall affect the production or supply of water (or both) made after the date of commencement of this Law, provided that such production or supply (or both) takes place from any water system or works in operation before that date.

## A LAW TO AMEND THE WATER (PRODUCTION AND SUPPLY) LAW, 1979

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Water (Production and Supply) (Amendment) Law, 1991.

Amendment of Section 2 of Law 15 of 1979.

- 2. Section 2 of the Water (Production and Supply) Law, 1979, (hereinafter called "the principal Law") is amended by inserting in its proper alphabetical place the following definition
  - " "domestic use" has the meaning assigned to that expression by section 2(1) of the Water Authority Law, 1982, but does not include condominiums, apartments, or other residential units which share common services;".

Amendment of s. 3 of the principal Law.

- 3. Section 3 of the principal Law is amended by -
  - (a) re-numbering the section as subsection (1);
  - (b) adding the following as subsection (2) -
    - "(2) Before the Governor may grant any concession under subsection (1) he shall seek the advice of the Water Authority which shall advise him pursuant to section 6(c) of the Water Authority Law, 1982.".
