**A LAW TO DIVEST THE CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY OF  
RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE CONTROL OF AIR TRAFFIC AND THE  
PROVISION OF AIR NAVIGATION SERVICES; TO CONFER UPON  
THE AUTHORITY RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE REGULATION OF  
AIR TRAFFIC; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED  
PURPOSES**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. (1) This Law may be cited as the Civil Aviation Authority (Amendment) Law, 2004. Short title and  
commencement
- (2) This Law shall be deemed to have come into force immediately after the coming into force of the Civil Aviation Authority Law, 2004.
2. The Civil Aviation Authority Law, 2004, is amended in section 5(1) as follows - Amendment of section 5  
of the Civil Aviation  
Authority Law, 2004 -  
functions of Authority
  - (a) in paragraph (a) by repealing the words “the control of air traffic” and substituting the words “the regulation of air traffic”; and
  - (b) by repealing paragraph (b).
