(Cap. 36)

The Dental (Government) Fees Regulations, 1967

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Administrator in Council by section 10 of the Dental Law the following Regulations are hereby made.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Dental (Government Fees) Regulations 1967 and shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Administrator by Government Notice published in the Cayman Islands.

2. The fees set out in the schedule hereto shall be payable in respect of any treatment, accommodation, amenities, facilities provided by or through the Government.

3. Any fees remaining unpaid for one month after demand in writing shall be recoverable by the Treasurer by suit in a summary way.
