THE OFFICIAL GAZETTE (PUBLICATION FEES)
REGULATIONS

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor in Council by Section 12 (b) of the above Law the following regulations are hereby made:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Official Gazette (Publication Fees) Regulations.
- 2. (a) The fees chargeable to the public for announcements in the Official Gazette otherwise than under the Patents and Trade Marks Law are at the rate of 15 cents per word.
(b) Regulation 8 of the Official Gazette Regulations is revoked.
- 3. The charge for publication in the Official Gazette of the recording of the extension of a United Kingdom Patent and Trade Mark right to the Islands is at the rate prescribed in the Schedule.
- 4. Applicants for recording of the extension of U.K. Patents and Trade Marks are required to remit the publication fee to the Registrar of Patents and Trade Marks, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, B.W.I. with their applications.
- 5. One copy of the relevant Gazette in respect of each Patent or Trade Mark publication will be sent post free by air mail to the proprietor or first-named proprietor of the recorded right, or to his named agent.

THE SCHEDULE

Publication in the Gazette of Patent — Trade Mark recordings will be preceded by the general heading (for which no charge will be raised) as follows:—

“The Patents and Trade Marks Law (No. 29 of 1975) (Section 12)

The following United Kingdom rights were recorded in the Islands on the day
of 197 ”

The fee charged for each item will be at the rate of \$60 per page and pages may be subdivided as follows.

One-sixth of a page	at \$10
One-quarter of a page	at \$15
One third of a page	at \$20
One half of a page	at \$30
Two thirds of a page	at \$40

The type area of a page is 7½' in height x 5¾'' across. Printing is in 8.5 point type unless some other type is requested. Trade Mark words will be printed in 12 point type or as otherwise requested. Two accurate reproductions of each mark must accompany each application. Blocks are not required.
