A LAW TO AMEND THE STATISTICS LAW (REVISED).

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Statistics (Amendment) Law, 1988.

Amendment of s. 2.

2. Section 2 of the Statistics Law (Revised), in this Law referred to as the principal Law, is amended by substituting -

- (a) “Unit” for “Department” in the first line of the definition of “Statistician” and by deleting “and” from the end of that definition;
- (b) a semicolon for the fullstop at the end of that section and by adding the following new definition -  
“ “Unit” means the Statistics Unit of the Department.”.

Amendment of s. 17.

3. Section 17 of the principal Law is amended by substituting “Unit” for “Department” in the penultimate line of subsection (3).

Amendment of s. 21.

4. Section 21 of the principal Law is amended by substituting “Unit” for “Department” in the last line of paragraph (e).
